1. **Determination of quorum; Call to Order.** The Open Meeting was called to order at 9:03 o'clock a.m. by Judge Shanklin. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The Court was led in prayer by Commissioner Epperson. The roll was then called by Clerk Reyes. All Commissioners, with the exception of Commissioner Reed, were present.

a. Pursuant to Section 551.074 of the Commissioner's Court will meet in Executive Session.

i. **EXECUTIVE SESSION (closed Meeting) pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.074. Discussion of Personal Matters.** Judge Shanklin called the Court into Executive Session at 9:05 a.m.

ii. **RECONVENE in Open Session to consider and/or act on matters considered in Executive Session.** Judge Shanklin announced the

Executive Session was concluded and he reconvened the Edwards County Commissioners Court in Open Session at 9:39 a.m. to consider and/or act on matters considered in Executive Session. b. Discussion and Vote to Post Position for a Road Department Foreman.

Commissioner Sweeten made a motion to hire a Foreman for the Road Department based on written requirements to be filed along with these minutes (with a copy in the Judge's office). Commissioner Epperson seconded the motion. 4/0. Commissioner Sweeten then made a motion that Edwards County should post a position for Foreman for the Edwards County Road Department using social media and newspapers to advertise the position. Locations where the job postings are to be made include Sonora, San Angelo, and Uvalde. Commissioner Fry seconded the motion. No Commissioner noting any opposition, the motion passed 4/0.
