The Agenda for this Regular Open Meeting was posted on May 4, 2023 at 1:19 p.m.

- 1. **Determination of quorum; Call to Order.** The Open Meeting was called to order at 9:00 o'clock a.m. by Judge Shanklin. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The Court was led in prayer by Commissioner Fry. The roll was then called by Clerk Reyes. All Commissioners were present.

- j. Discuss and Act upon Preliminary Correction Plat for L & M Ranch Sterling Martin Commissioner Grooms Pct 4. This subdivision was created in the 1990's but it was never recorded at the Clerk's office. Commissioner Grooms made the motion to allow the L & M Ranch to file a Correction Plat for the L & M Ranch. Commissioner Fry seconded the motion. No Commissioner noting any opposition, the motion carried 5/0.
- k. Discuss and act upon Water Availability Study (Collier Consulting) in partnership with Real-Edwards Conservation & Reclamation District Judge Shanklin. The County will get a Memorandum of Understanding or Contract from Collier regarding a partnership for the Water Availability Studies. Commissioner Grooms made the motion to approve the Water Availability Study (Collier Consulting) in partnership with Real-Edwards Conservation & Reclamation District. Commissioner Fry seconded the motion. No Commissioner noting any opposition, the motion carried 5/0.
- I. Discussion on minimum lot size for subdivision regulations. Judge Shanklin. Sterling Martin led the Court in a discussion regarding the minimum lot size for the subdivision regulations. The court tabled the discussion and will place this item on a future agenda. No action was taken.
